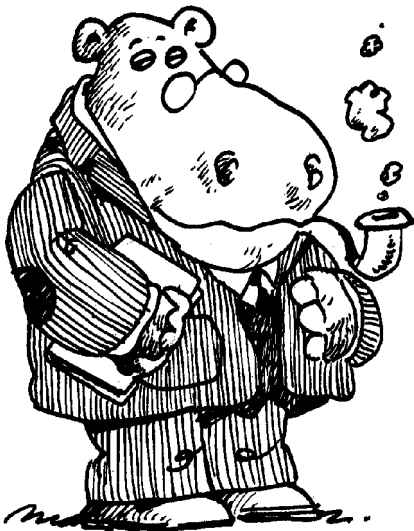

“How-To” Manual

This is a clearly organized 600+page, three-ring binder of policies, procedures, resources and appendices to provide evidence of functional compliance with the Department of Health and Human Services' HIPAA regulations. Resources include forms, template letters, logs, checklists, and flow charts. Appendix includes federal and state laws applicable to HIPAA. The manual covers the most critical areas of HIPAA's patient health information privacy requirements.

Authors

A task force composed of representatives from three networks, Great Plains Health Alliance, Sunflower Health Network and Med-OP, prepared the document. A multidisciplinary approach was utilized including input from health information management, nursing, ancillary departments, long-term care, physician clinics, administration, and business offices.

This manual represents the judgment and decisions of the task force and is being offered as a general method to begin to implement the privacy regulations. It is not intended to fit the precise needs of every provider. It is also not intended to be legal advice. Each institution and provider using this manual should seek independent legal advice prior to implementing any policies.

Contents

The manual is divided into sections, with an appendix and index. The sections include the Preface, Acknowledgements, Definitions, Privacy Officer/Contact Person/Privacy Oversight Committee, Workforce and Medical Staff Policies, Business Associate Contracts, Organization Policies on Protected Health Information with Disclosure and Special Rules, Patient Rights, and Organization, Documentation and Retention.
